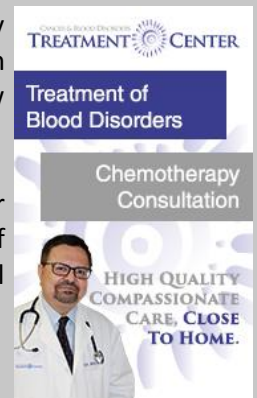

Immunization Tips

1. According to the National Public Health Information Coalition, an annual flu vaccine is recommended for all children 6 months and older.
2. Before becoming pregnant, women should make sure they are up-to-date on vaccinations to help protect themselves and their child.
3. For kids, staying on a recommended vaccination schedule can protect them for 14 diseases including measles and whooping cough.
